Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the above listed offices must file in the City Clerk's office, Hartsville City Hall, 100 East Carolina Ave, Monday – Friday 8:30am – 5:00pm. Books will open for filing at 12 noon on Thursday, August 1, 2019 and remain open during regular business hours until 12 noon on Thursday, August 15, 2019.

The **NON-REFUNDABLE** filing fee for the office of Councilmember is \$203.84.

At 9:00am on said Election Day the Poll Managers will begin examination of the absentee ballots return envelopes. This examination will be held at the Darlington County Board of Elections and Registration at 131 Cashua Street, Darlington, SC.

On Thursday, November 7, 2019 at 10:00am at 135 Cashua Street in Darlington, SC the Darlington County Board of Elections and Registration will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election and to certify the election.

Any runoff will be held two weeks after the general election on Tuesday, November 19, 2019.

The polling locations will be open from 7a.m. until 7 p.m. as follows:

- Precinct #1: First Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall at 213 West Home Avenue (will include Kelleytown city precinct) For districts #4 and #6.
- Precinct #4: Darlington County Outreach Building at 404 South Fourth Street For District #2.
- Precinct #5: Coach T.B. Thomas Sports Center at 701 West Washington Street For District # 4 and #6.
- Precinct #6: Jerusalem Baptist Church Fellowship Hall at 301 South 6th Street For District #2.
- Precinct #7: **for this election only will vote at the First Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall at 213 West Home Avenue.** For District #6.
- Precinct #8: North Hartsville Elementary School, 110 School Drive For District #6.
